

Livingston Township Minutes of the Special Meeting August 15, 2016

The Special meeting of the Livingston Township Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M., on August 15, 2016, and conducted by the open meetings Act #267, with the Pledge of Allegiance. All board members present, and no visitors. This meeting is to approve ballot language to raise funds for the Township's share of a new firetruck for the county fire department for one year. Motion by Dipzinski, seconded by Brecheisen, to approve the ballot language attached to these minutes, to submit the proposal to the electors at the November 8, 2016 general election, and to certify the ballot language to the Township Clerk and County Clerk as required by law. The ballot language is to approve the Proposal for Fire Truck Millage, this proposal will permit the Township to levy up to 0.8 mills for the purpose of providing funds to pay the Township's share of a new fire truck and equipment for the Otsego County Fire Board. Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Livingston, Otsego County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 0.8 mills (\$.80 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of one (1) year (2016), for the purpose of providing funds to pay the Township's share of anew fire truck with equipment for the Otsego County Fire Board, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimate \$97,337.00 for the Township when levied in 2016. Roll call taken all in favor Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
