It was moved by Mench and supported by Carlson to accept the Resolution number 2014-08-22-01, to accept the Millage rate of .9000. Roll call taken. All in favor. It was moved by Carlson and supported by Prusakiewicz to allow Supervisor Brecheisen to sign the Livingston Township Service Agreement for Economic Development Support. Roll call taken. All in favor. It was moved by Mench and supported by Brecheisen to allow a closed session by the Clerk.
