

Livingston Township Minutes June 23, 2014

The regular meeting of the Livingston Township Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on June 23, 2014, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting, which was conducted by open meetings Act #267, was Mench, Carlson, Brecheisen, and Prusakiewicz, and Dipzinski. One visitor was present. It was moved by Carlson and supported by Dipzinski to accept the consent agenda, and pay bills in the amount of \$38,768.05. Motion passed. It was moved by Brecheisen and supported by Carlson for the purchase of a new microwave not to exceed \$200.00. Motion passed. It was moved by Brecheisen and Supported by Carlson to enter into the agreement between City of Gaylor and Township of Livingston Regarding Overpayment of Certain Revenue Sharing in the amount of \$14,400.00. Roll call was taken. Agreement passed. Prusakiewicz excused early. It was moved by Mench and supported by Brecheisen to approve the fireworks permit presented by Dennis Freeman for July 12, 2014, contingent upon the approval by the fire chief Dave Duffield. Motion passed. It was moved by Mench and Supported by Dipzinski to send the election inspectors to training on July 24, 2014 at 1:00p.m. Motion was passed.
