

Livingston Township Minutes March 26, 2012

The regular meeting of the Livingston Township Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on March 26, 2012, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting, which was conducted by open meetings Act #267, was Dipzinski, Mench, Prusakiewicz, and Brecheisen, and Carlson. Twenty One visitors were present, including Road Commissioner Tholl. The Road Commission was there to present the Poquette Road Project and explain the cost and schedule for the project. It was moved by Dipzinski and supported by Carlson to approve the consent agenda and approve the bills in the amount of \$109,531.55. It was moved by Dipzinski and supported by Brecheisen to approve the Resolution to finalize the Township of Livingston Resolution Regarding Annexation of Parcel One, Arthur Land Company, PB Gas station and Parcel Two, Gaelic Financial Services and Gordon Food Services, roll call taken, All in Favor. It was moved by Brecheisen and supported by Dipzinski to allow the election inspectors and clerk to attend the class with the Bureau of elections on April 19, 2012. It was moved by Mench and supported by Prusakiewicz to allow the board members to attend the joint Planning Commission meeting on April 10th, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. Budget hearing was called to order at 8:00 p.m. It was moved by Brecheisen and supported by Dipzinski to approve the budget expenses for the year 2012-2013 in the amount of \$584,413.00. Roll call was taken. Budget adopted. It was moved by Brecheisen and supported by Mench to accept resolution number 2012-3-26-01 the Salaries and wage schedule for the 2012-2013 fiscal year. Roll call was taken all in favor. Resolution adopted. The budget hearing closed 8:15 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m. Next Regular meeting will be April 23, 2011 at 6:30 p.m.
