

Livingston Township Minutes January 25, 2021

The regular meeting of the Livingston Township Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on January 25, 2021, and conducted by the Open Meetings Act #267, with the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken, Dipzinski excused with four board members present via zoom. Two guests were present on the zoom call, District 3 Commissioner Paul Liss and the newest Planning Commission Member Tara Gerstenberger, per the Open Meetings Act, as amended by Public Act SB 1246, which allows virtual meetings to be held for any reason through March 30, 2021, and following the Resolution 03-23-2020-04, Establishing Procedures to Allow Telephonic Attendance by Livingston Township Board Members and Members of the Public at meetings Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic remains in effect. The township meet via Zoom under the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services [epidemic order](#) released January 13, 2021, Which states “All indoor meetings of a public nature, all township meetings must remain virtual until Feb. 21,2021. It was moved by Carlson and supported by Prusakiewicz, to accept the consent agenda and pay bills in the amount of \$39,439.37. The hall will be closed to the public until March 15, 2021 to finish renovations currently being done. It was moved by Prusakiewicz and supported by Mench to hold a budget workshop February 22, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. The next meeting will be February 22, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. Meeting will be held at the hall providing the order to resume public meetings in person is in effect. Meeting adjourned at 6:53 p.m.
