

Livingston Township Minutes November 23, 2020

The regular meeting of the Livingston Township Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on November 23, 2020, and conducted by the open meetings Act #267, with the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken, all board members present via Zoom per the Order of the DHHS, Which states “All indoor meetings of a public body must be held completely virtually, if at all, between Nov. 18 and Dec. 8, 2020, under a new Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) emergency order that goes into effect on Wednesday, November 18, 2020. The order enacts a three-week “pause” targeting indoor gatherings and other group activities in an effort to curb rapidly rising COVID-19 infection rates. The Open Meetings Act, as amended by Public Act 228 of 2020, allows virtual meetings to be held for any reason through Dec. 31, 2020.” The Resolution 03-23-2020-04, Establishing Procedures to Allow Telephonic Attendance by Livingston Township Board Members and Members of the Public at meetings Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic remains in effect. Commissioner Mason arrived and did not stay due to the meeting being held via Zoom. It was moved by Prusakiewicz and supported by Brecheisen to accept the consent agenda and pay bills in the amount of \$14,520.69. Motion passed. It was moved by Mench and supported by Prusakiewicz to adopt Resolution 11-23-2020-01 to reinstate the Salary and Wage schedule of 20-21, effective immediately, roll call was taken, all in favor. It was moved by Prusakiewicz and supported by Mench to appoint Richard Carlson as the representative for the Fireboard for the next (4) four-year term and appoint Norm Brecheisen as the chairperson representative for the next (6) six-year term. roll call taken. Four ayes and one could not respond due to an issue with the sound. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 6:45 pm. The next meeting will be December 28, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. Meeting will be held at the hall practicing social distancing per the Governor.
